We have no greater responsibility than to ensure the safety of the children in our communities. Back in September 2003, Cardinal George launched the "Covenant to Protect Children" initiative. The Office for the Protection of Children and Youth (OPCY) not only continues to carry out the tenets of this Covenant but is constantly looking at ways to improve upon it.

In the ongoing effort to improve the protection of all children, many program are being developed and updated. These are at our disposal and may be utilized to supplement our own program of instruction for adults and in the education of our children to better recognize dangerous behavior. They also provide assistance in equipping our children with important tools needed for their own protection. This year, the list of acceptable child safety education programs include:
